- Cafe project:
- Nancy Talbot met with Jill Walker from the Foundry. Foundry will fund one barista/kitchen assistant for two days a week for three months. If successful the worker could continue to be funded by the summer student grant for another three months.
 - Wired for Success is another programme that could supply workers.
 - The project is still in early stages and it seems worth putting another year into bringing it to self-sustainability. It's life-giving and community-building.
